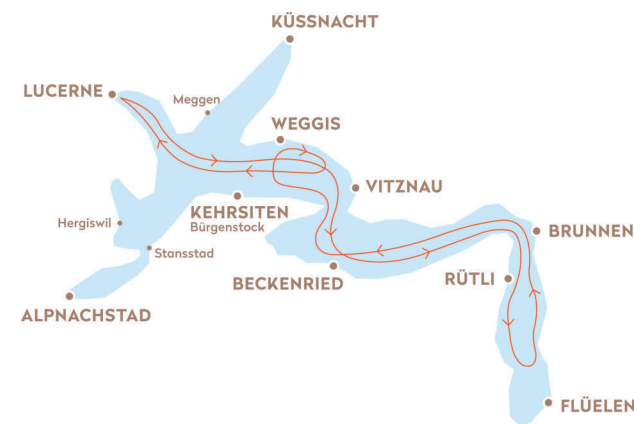

## YOUR ROUTE



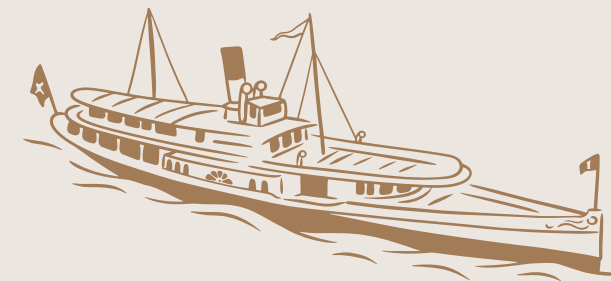

- to **Weggis**, once visited by Mark Twain,
- past **Mount Rigi**, majestically gliding by your window,
- through the wild beauty of the southern part of the lake, the **Urnersee**, to the **Rütli Meadow**, where the Swiss Confederates once took their oath,
- and to the **Tell's Chapel**, where William Tell still seems to stand carved into the cliffs.
- On the way back, you'll pass the **Bürgenstock**,
- while Mount **Pilatus** towers silently over the bay like a watchful guardian.



# STEAMBOAT GALLIA
